### FUTURISTIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS

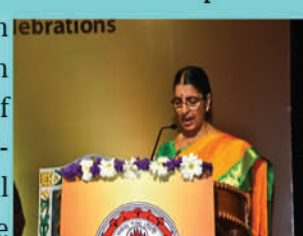
