


Participants were given 5topics each which were selected from a spinner board and the topics were as follows:

"We do learn by answering questions and we do feed our knowledge to answer those questions". All the student - participants were active and participated vibrantly.


NAVARATHRI CELEBRATION

ETHNIC CLOAKS






DIWALI CELEBRATION
