





NFSMD

Graphics plays a key role in the digital world. Canva is a free-to-use online graphic designing tool that helps in creating amazing design quickly.











Plant protein sources on the other hand have a different amino acid profile from that of animal protein. Incorporating the right types and amounts of protein in your diet will not only optimize muscle growth and repair. It will help maintain immune system function, reduce the risk for many diseases and help improve energy levels.



TED TALK - WORKSHOP ON POSTER DEVELOPMENT



A Survey on Awareness of MOOC (SWAYAM) Program Emphasizing the Importance of Digital Learning


