

PLAGIARISM POLICY

The objective of the Journal is to publish original research/ review articles. The articles that does not satisfy the Plagiarism policy will never be considered for publication

- As a Preliminary step of Review Policy, all submitted articles undergoes a Plagiarism check using a software. The accepted plagiarism is less than 10%.
- If the article reports Plagiarism above 10 % then the article is returned to the respective author with the results.
- If the article reports Plagiarism less than 10 % then the article is moved forward to the Review process where paper id is allocated and is forwarded to the Reviewer for the comments.
- If the article is accepted with Revisions, then it is checked again for Plagiarism and if it satisfies the policy then only it is moved forward for publication.
