Association meeting was held on 19/09/2017 presided over by Dr. L. Selvanathan, Associate Professor and HOD, Department of History, Loyola College.

One workshop on 'Brahmi script' was conducted to on 06.10.2017 to enrich the students about the ancient Brahmi script. The workshop was presided over by **Dr.R. Poongundran**, Assistant Director, (Retd.,) Dept. of .Archaeology, State Govt. of Tamil Nadu, along with **Dr. G.Sasikala**, Archaeolosist and Temple Historian. Dr.R. Poongundran is an expert in Tamil Epigraphical studies. The work shop was aimed at creating awareness among the students on ancient scripts especially the Brahmi script. The work shop enhanced the student's knowledge on ancient script and our cultural heritage.

On 28/11/2017, the department of History and Tourism conducted an Inter-Department national level examination on behalf of National Commission for Women, Government of India to create awareness on women's rights. Students from both Day and Evening stream participated in large numbers. The First prize winner was awarded Rs. 2000 in cash where as Second and Third prize winners won Rs. 1500 and Rs. 1000 respectively.

36 students from III B.A. History were taken **on a three day educational tour to Coorg** between 25/01/218 and 28/01/2018. The students visited Iruppu falls a cascade, located in the Brahmagiri Range in the Kodagu district of Karnataka, Visited Dubare forest (Dubare is known for its elephant camp) and enjoyed the adventurous and fun filled river crossing. Our next stop over was Cauvery Nisargadhama, a beautiful 64-acre island, surrounded by the Cauvery River, which was accessed by walking across a hanging bridge. The trip came to an end by visiting Golden Temple or Namdroling Monastery, a beautiful Buddhist Monastery situated in Bylakuppe. (Bylakuppe is the second largest Tibetans settlement in India after Dharamshala).
