

THE COLLEGE CREST



The College Crest is enshrined within a lotus in full bloom to represent the cult of the devotion preached by Mahaprabhu Shri Vallabhacharya. At the centre of the Crest is a sacrificial fire, which symbolizes the Lord himself "Yagna Vai Vishnu". The Lord is reached by the three steps of the altar signifying KSHARA, AKSHARA AND POORNA PURUSHOTHAMA. 





