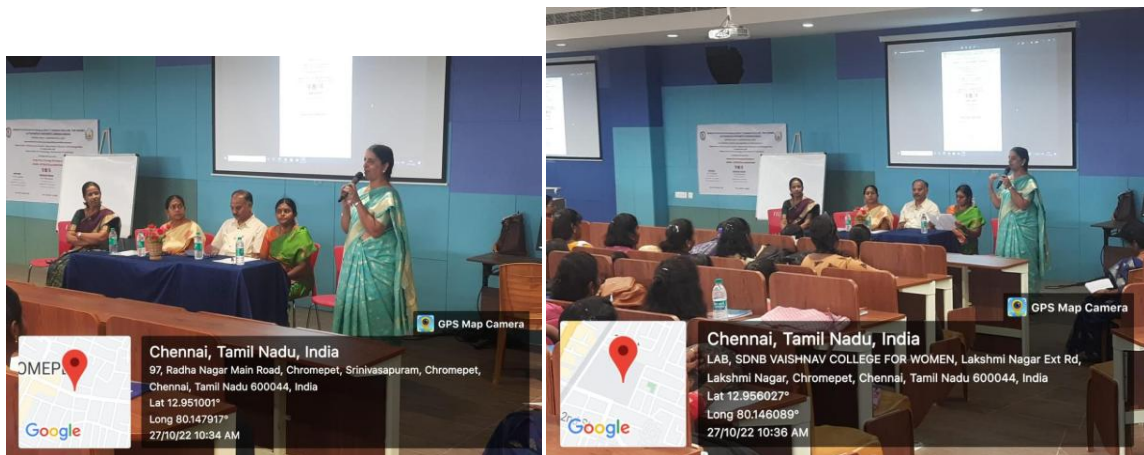
## Workshop on Tamizh,Vatteluttu and Grantham

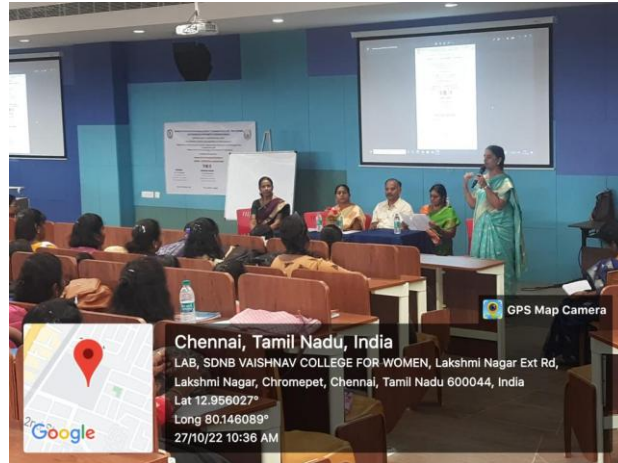

The Chief Guest was Dr.R.Sivanantham – Commissioner (FAC) Department of Archaeology, Government of Tamil Nadu, The Resource persons are Mrs.K.Bakalakshimi – Department of Archaeology, Government of Tamil Nadu and Dr.G.Sasikala – Epigraphist State Archaeology, Government of Tamil Nadu.

Tamizhi,Vatteluttu and Grantham Report are two separate topics. Tamizhi Vatteluttu refers to an ancient Tamil script which was used to write Tamil language, whereas Grantham report is a Sanskrit text.
