INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Last date for submission of proposal along with budget is 30th June 2023.
- 2. The duration of the project is from 15th July 2023 to 15th January 2024.
- 3. Students' Project can be carried over as a group project
 - Maximum of 4 students in a project is allowed.
 - A staff from respective department must be the supervisor for the project.
 - It is the responsibility of the staff to see to that the students complete the project and submit the thesis on time.
- 4. The students are requested to submit monthly progress report to the research cell in the prescribed format duly signed by the guide.
- 5. The Students are requested to present their progress as presentation after 2 months to the research cell. Date, Time and Venue for the presentation will be intimated.
- 6. The students are expected to complete their project by the mid of January 2024 with documentation and Statement of expenditure.
- 7. The final presentation will be scheduled in the last week of January 2024.
- 8. Interdisciplinary projects can be undertaken.
- 9. Proposal format is available in our college website which can be downloaded.

General Instructions

- 1. Student projects will be eligible for a maximum grant of Rs.20,000/-.
- 2. The project team (batch) can have up to a maximum of four students. A team should send only one proposal.
- 3. It may be noted that the project proposal should be of original, innovative and novel.
- 4. The project proposals can be submitted to Dean of Research on or before 30th June 2023. Budget is to be given with the proper head of expenditure.
- 5. They should have utility and applicability for implementation. Kindly note that the evaluation of the project is also based on these factors.
- 6. The Project Guides / HODs needs to evaluate the project proposals and scrutiny them before sending the project proposals to the Research cell.
- 7. The project team should not change the topic and should not deviate from the objectives of the sanctioned project proposal.
- 8. Project proposals received will be reviewed and evaluated by a team of experts and those selected will be announced in our college website.
- 9. The sanctioned projects should be completed and the report should be submitted before end of January 2024.
- 10. The Utilization Certificate (UC) and Statement of Expenditure (SE) should be signed by the guide.
- 11. Voucher amount should not exceed Rs.200/-
- 12. Proper bills and summary of the expenses should be submitted along with the report.

General Instructions for Interdisciplinary Projects

- 1. Interdisciplinary projects will be more preferable.
- 2. Each department should have a separate guide.
- 3. Guides and students should give the undertaking for presentation, publications and patent.
