

ANNUAL REPORT OF RESEARCH DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-22

Research Department of Commerce and Sraddha Academy for Financial Education jointly organized a Faculty Development Program on 'Investor Education & Awareness - An initiative of Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) on 24th September, 2021. Shri. Shankar Sundaresan, spoke about the various investment opportunities in Banking and Financial services industry.

Research Department of Commerce organised a Virtual Vaish comfest "Sanguinity"- 2k21 on 22nd November 2021. Dr.N.Raja Hussain, Additional Registrar B.S.A. Crescent Institute of Science and Technology, Vandalur, Chennai inaugurated Virtual Vaish comfest "Sanguinity"- 2k21 and he spoke about Women Empowerment in his inaugural address. A variety of interclass competitions like "Comm-advert", Farrago (photo Montage), E-Biz and Jibber Jabber (Find the Gibberish Slogan) were held to bring out the hidden talents of the students. In the interclass competitions our students showed great interest and involvement while displaying their talents. On 23rd November 2021 Intercollegiate competitions like T-Shirt Painting, Poster making, "Comm-advert" and "Channel Surfing" competitions were conducted. Students from nearly 30 colleges participated in various intercollegiate competitions and Patrician College of Arts and Science won the overall trophy. Mr. Arvind Vijayagopalan, Director and Founder Biotasoil Foundation delivered the Valedictory Address. He spoke about personal social responsibility which is the need of the hour.

On 8th March 2022 the Research department of Commerce and institution's innovation council organised a special lecture on "Startup management". The guest speaker was Dr.Roshini, Director, AAM Business School and educational entrepreneur. She motivated the students to become entrepreneurs, have innovative ideas and start their own start ups. She focussed on three areas namely simplification and handholding, funding support and incentives and industry-academia partnership and incubation. College should encourage entrepreneurship and commercialization of bright plans by activating the startup environment.

The guest speaker was CA.K.Gokulraj, Founder director of KEW academy and AXUS Learn. He emphasized that one of the most important aspects of being a successful entrepreneur is being financially prepared for the best as well as for the worst. Entrepreneurship and financial planning are two sides of the same coin. Investors and venture capitalists tend to see business plans including financial plans and projections or assumptions behind a forecast. A common mistake made by entrepreneurs is that their financial projections are too unrealistic and unattainable, leading to not achieving the desired funding. Hence, it is always advised to have proper financial management and get the desired guidance by a certified financial planner.

On 14th March 2022 the Research department of Commerce arranged a faculty development program on Neuro marketing. Dr.Abhishek Ganeshan, Founder- PDF consultants, Chennai emphasized that Neuro marketing was a commercial marketing communication field that applies neuropsychology to market research, studying consumers' sensori motor, cognitive, and affective responses to marketing stimuli. The potential benefits of Neuro marketing to marketers include more efficient and effective marketing campaigns and strategies, fewer product and campaign failures, and ultimately the manipulation of the real needs and wants of people to suit the needs and wants of marketing interests.

On 19th March 2022 the Research department of Commerce organised a special lecture on careers in Financial Markets. The guest speaker was Mr.B.Damodharan, Founder of trade bees trading and training academy. He motivated the students and said that the financial market has a vast range of opportunities to offer.
