THE CPR WORKSHOP









MAGIC MILLETS

Home science – Nutrition, Food Service Management, and Dietetics (NFSMD) branch carried out a collection of consciousness programs namely a drama on 'Brain Foods', a puppet show on 'Balanced Diet', and an attention speak on 'Magic Millets' on Christ King Girl's Higher Secondary School, East Tambaram from 09:00 am onwards. The session started with welcome tackle with the aid of Dr. P. Radha, Joint Vice President, Outreach Club. Then the first software an attention talk about millets used to be given by way of the students. It was given in both English and Tamil. 






ANAEMIA SCREENING CAMP AND DIET COUNSELLING

It used to be inititated through ICDs and the program started with welcome address given by Dr. V. Subasshini, Club president and ICDs organizer. The application started out with measuring the heights and weights of adolescent girls. It was once referred to and they have been screened for anaemia. Then, weight-reduction plan counselling was once given through college students of the outreach club and nutrition department. The college students explained the motives of anaemia, its symptoms, and its affect on the fitness of adolescent girls. They also listed meals rich in iron and advised more than a few iron-rich recipes that have to be protected in the weight loss program of an anaemic person.
