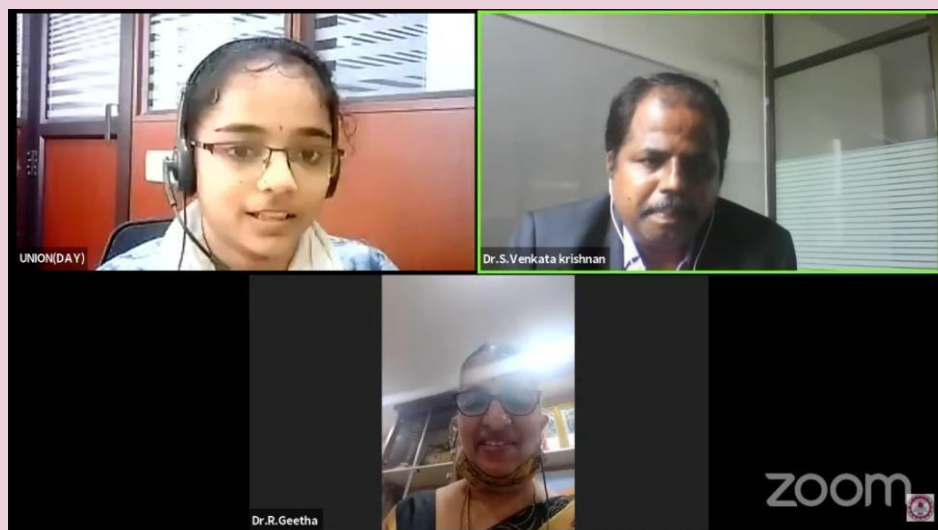




International Day Of Peace

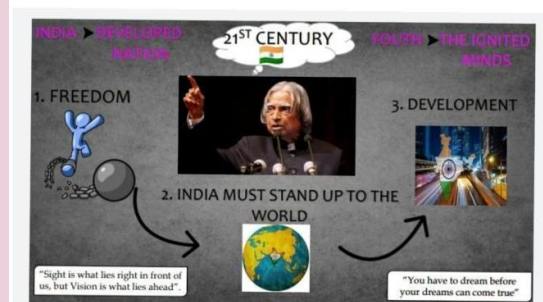
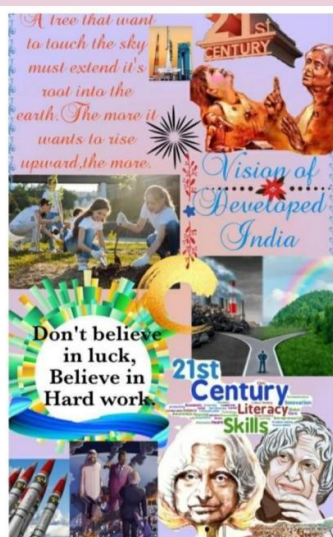

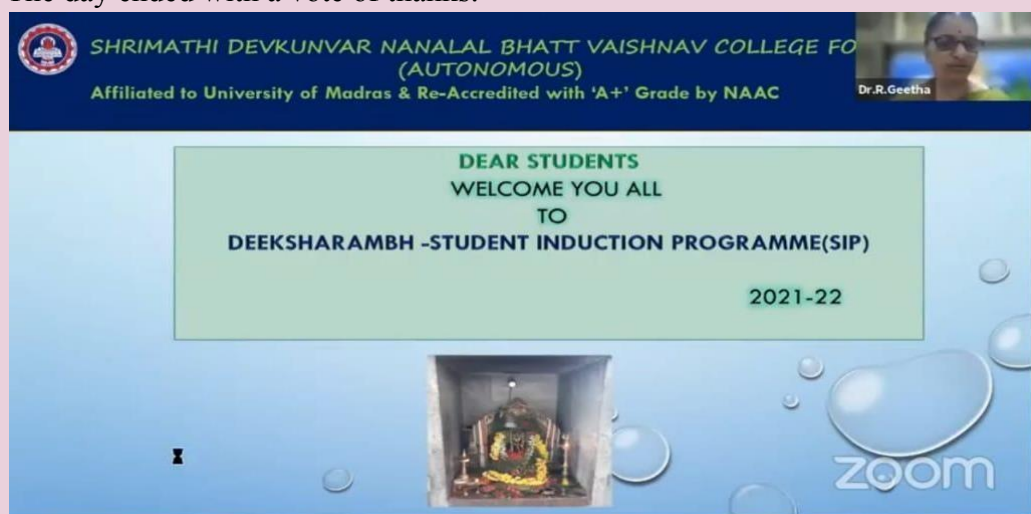

The day started with our college prayer.

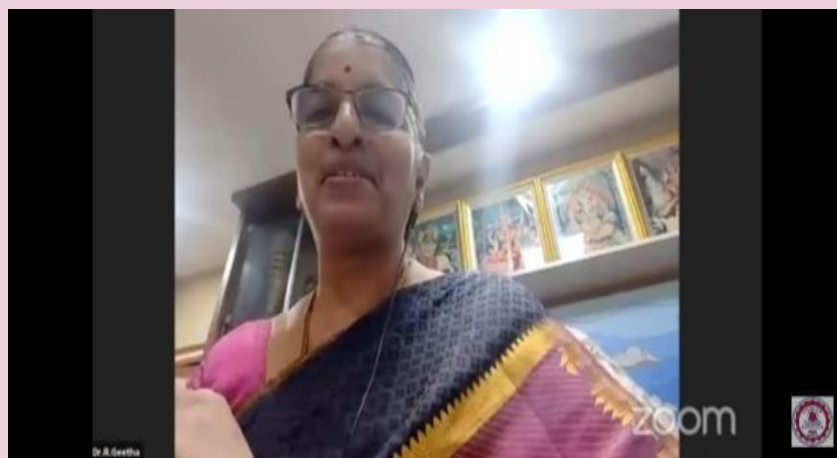

The day ended with principal mam’s words and vote of thanks.



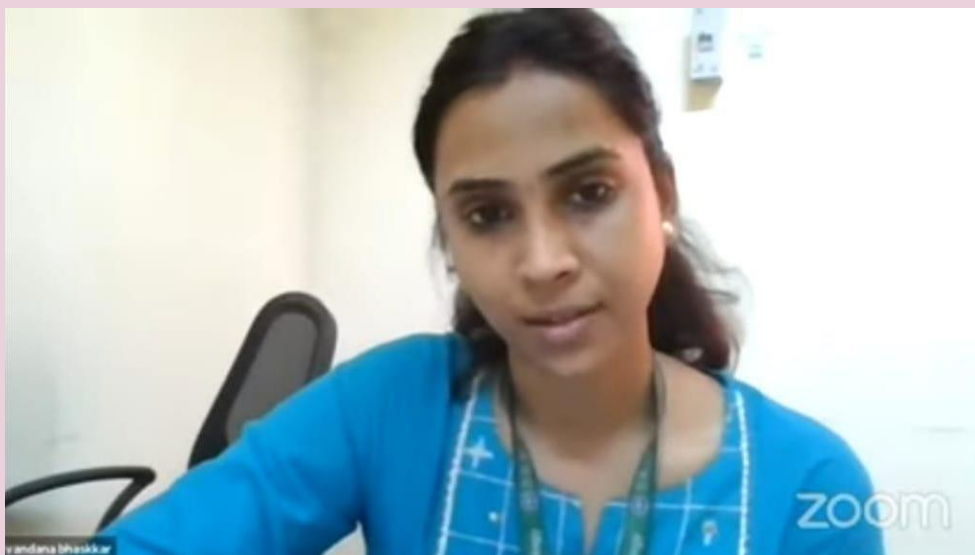
DAY 3 - 06.10.2021

The day started with our college prayer.

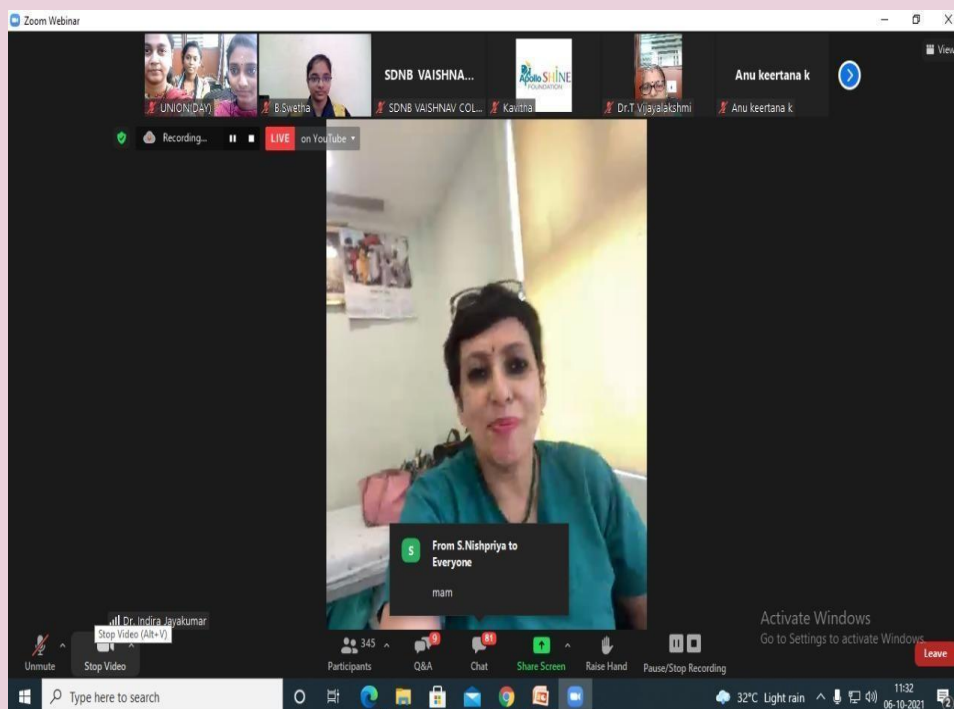

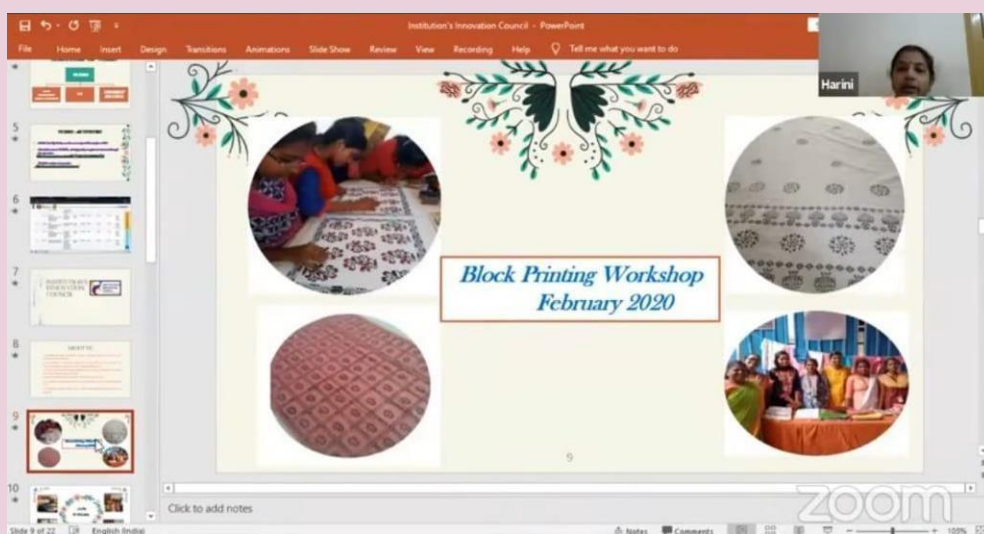
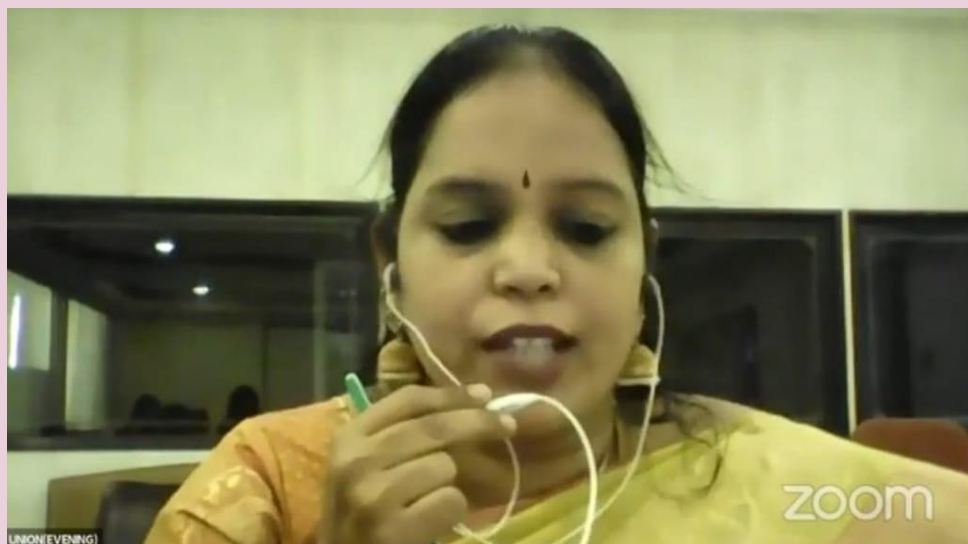
- **Student Council**

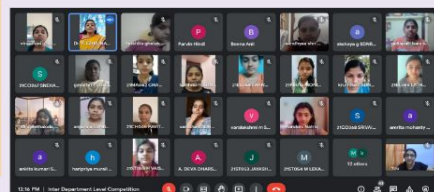
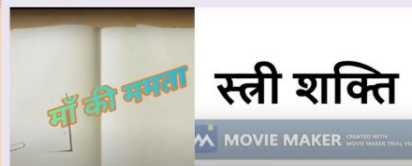
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Screenshot Of Inter Department Level Hindi Competitions --- 2021-2022

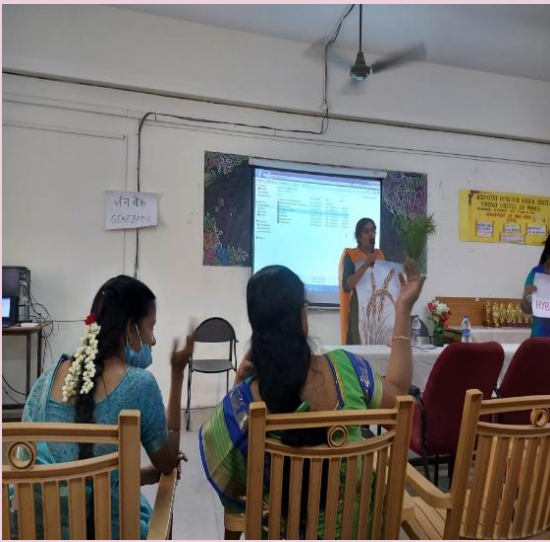
During the lecture session , Dr. Lavanya gave an elaborate speech on the topic – ‘The Plethora of New Writing Trends in Hindi.’

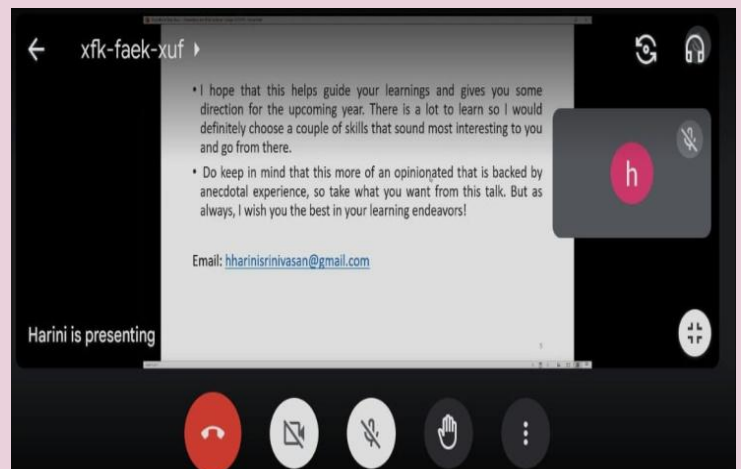
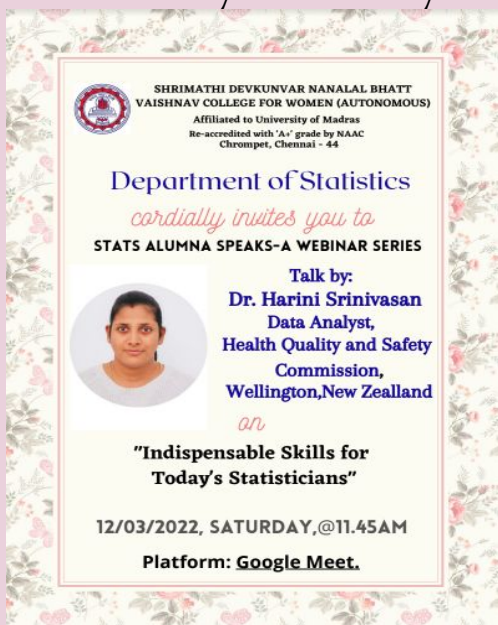


REPORT ON WEBINAR
